

Uniform Policy

Kings Kids Christian School pupils should wear their uniform with pride, be smart and tidy in their overall appearance and be a credit to the public image of the school. Clothing that is untidy, dirty, badly worn or does not look smart is unacceptable. The uniform has been designed to be modest, comfortable, gender specific, contemporary and culturally appropriate to suit different body shapes and sizes; giving value for money and be easy-care. The uniform also consists of a backpack with the school logo.

These are the guidelines we expect all pupils, parents and guardians to adhere to whilst they are associated with Kings Kids Christian School:

1. Correct school uniform must be worn to and from school, at school and for school events, unless special dispensation has been given by the Head Teacher. Details of the uniform requirements are given in the Uniform Policy.
2. Pupils must be well turned out at all times. Appearance should not be ostentatious and pupils must comply with the requirements regarding jewellery in the Uniform Policy. Hair must be sensibly styled and of a natural colour, and of a length and style which is acceptable to the Head Teacher.
3. Uniforms should comply with decency and neatness. Girls' pinafores and skirts should be below their knees when they are seated and boy's trousers neat and pressed with no holes.
4. Non uniform items of clothing **may not be worn** with the school uniform at school or at school events.
5. All clothing must be marked with the owner's name.
6. Behaviour that harms others, disrupts teaching and learning or damages the school's reputation is unacceptable. This includes whilst in school uniform outside of the school premises.

School Uniform Guidelines

Kings Kids Christian School has a standard uniform that **ALL** pupils must comply with. These items are as follows:

Boys Uniform Items

Shirt: White

Tie: School Tie

Jumper - Maroon with the school logo

Trousers - Dark grey

Blazer-Navy blue with school logo

Shoes -black

Bag - Maroon bag with school logo

Girls Uniform Items

Skirt - grey skirt (below the knees) **OR** Pinafore - grey

Blouse - white with collar

Jumper - Maroon with school logo

Blazer- Navy blue with school logo

Tie - School Tie

Shoes - black

Hosiery -white socks or dark grey tights

Hat - School Maroon Hat

Summer Dress: Pink Gingham summer dresses can be worn in the summer, instead of the pinafore, shirt, tie and jumper

Bag - Maroon bag with school logo

Friday - P.E. Day. Both Boys and Girls are required to come in their P.E. Attire, which consists of **(for both boys and girls):**

P.E. Shirt - with school logo on it

Bottoms - Navy blue track suit bottoms

Training Shoes - Sports shoes (trainers or plimsolls).

Uniforms may be obtained from the school office by sending an email to: admin@kkcs.org.uk, stating your requirements and the age and sizes of your child/children. The complete school uniform **must** be purchased upon admission into the school and must be worn daily unless, told otherwise.

Jewellery

No jewellery may be worn by either girls or boys at any time on the school premises. The wearing of makeup is not permitted. Pupils may not wear nail polish or false nails. Watches are to be plain and standard-sized, not over-sized.

Hair

All our pupils' hair must be smart and neat. Hairstyles must be gender and culturally appropriate and not ostentatious. No extremes of fashion are permitted including dreadlocks, swirls and geometric cuts. Pupils are not permitted to have patterns shaved into the hair. Boys' hair must be above collar length with no pony-tails. For safety reasons girls' hair must be tied back and off their face. Extensions and weaves are only acceptable if they look natural. Girls' hair accessories must be black or royal blue, plain and modestly sized.

Footwear

Each pupil requires one pair of black leather school shoes for wear with the school uniform. For girls, this means lace-ups, moccasin style or traditional school shoes with one strap. **High or kitten heels, platform soles, pumps, court shoes, open-toed or backless sandals, suede, patent, patterned or decorated fashion shoes** are not permitted to be worn as part of the school uniform. Girls' heels must not be more than 1" high. Boys' shoes must not be of the trainer type. All shoes need to be clean and polished when coming to school.

Monitoring of School Uniform Guidelines

Any infringements to the uniform guidelines outlined in this policy are dealt with promptly. Any non-uniform items will be confiscated and kept in a secure place for an extended period until collected by the parent. Serious infringements may result in the pupil being placed on disciplinary action. The decision of the Head Teacher is final.
